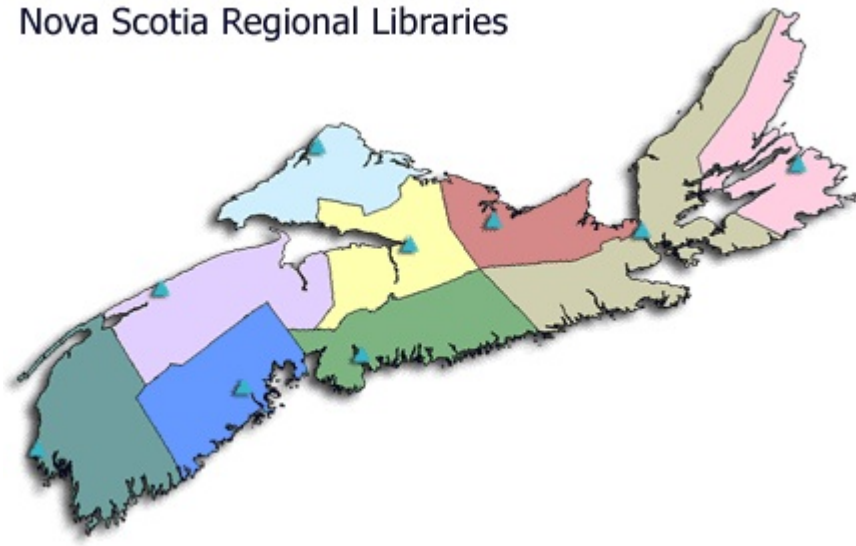











Nova Scotia Regional Libraries



Each of the 9 regions is managed by its own library board and **receives funds to provide the library service** from:

- Province of Nova Scotia
- Municipal Councils
- cost recoveries (fines, fees, etc.)
- donations, grants

Library service costs include staffing, books and other library materials, computers, program supplies, as well as expenses to operate headquarters, i.e. office space, equipment and supplies, vehicles, professional services, postage and shipping, etc.
